Anita has been contacting college coaches regarding having their swimmers join a Masters Club during the winter holidays and summer break so that they can continue training. She received feedback regarding the added expense of USMS membership being a financial challenge for many college swimmers.

There was discussion regarding USA-Swimming Club Membership versus USMS Club Membership costs and the possibility of SPMS potentially offering a reduced USMS membership for college swimmers in the future.

Anita said that Dan had ordered 333 white swim caps with the SPMS logo. She would like to be able to order more swim caps next year, including some in neon colors or other colors for both pool and open water swimmers. Anita will send a proposal for the swim caps to Bob to include in the budget for next year.

Robert asked if it would be possible for the local newspapers/media to report on the upcoming USAS Annual Convention next month in Anaheim. Anita will look into this.

OLD BUSINESS

Belmont Plaza Pool:

Lucy reported earlier in the meeting that the construction on the temporary outdoor pool has started with the deconstruction of the parking lot. Construction will need to be completed within 85 days (October 31st). The pool will later be repurposed as a permanent outdoor pool (53 meters by 25 meters). The Project Manager for the proposed indoor permanent pool will be selected by bid shortly, followed by selection of the Construction Manager and the Design Team through separate bids. The plans are still going through review and approval by the planning commission and the coastal commission including environmental impact assessments. There has apparently been lots of interest in this project from major development firms around the country (outside of California).
