There were 3 dual sanctioned meets in past 30 days. Two of three were a heats and finals format. The USMS database does not accept the uploaded times submitted with this formatting. Therefore, I will be working with admin officials and meet operations to create a different requirement regarding submission of the files and results when there are a heats and finals format.

Submitted a policy change to SPMS regarding the bond requirement. Currently, a bond of \$250 is required by all teams requesting to sanction a Masters swim meet regarding submission of results. I am proposing that the bond requirement for all meet hosts be removed and the penalties for non-compliance reflect a 3-tier punitive consequence. The bond requirement for all meet hosts was a worthwhile temporary solution for SPMS.

I am pleased to report that over the past 5 seasons, there was only one occurrence of a meet host not submitting the files and results to the Top Ten Recorder on a timely basis. The team was penalized \$50. Therefore, I am recommending a new policy that will only target those that abuse the system.

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
