Annual Meeting Agenda

Welcome and Introductions:

Mark welcomed everyone to the meeting and requested that everyone introduce themselves.

-MSP- To approve the October 15, 2015 Meeting Minutes



LMSC Committee Business:

Dues Increase-

Bob presented the issue around the increase in USMS registration fees and history of SPMS registration fees. There was discussion around the timing of when registration fees amounts are set versus when the annual registration period begins.

-MSP- To approve keeping the SPMS Registration Fee at \$15.00. Motion passed with one member opposed.

Reimbursement of Dues-

Program Developer Seminar-

Mark announced that USMS will be offering a USMS/LMSC Aquatics Program Developer Seminar in SPMS. It is currently scheduled for Saturday February 20, 2016 in Mission Viejo. More information regarding registration for the seminar and other details to be announced in the future. Mark has appointed Anita Cole to be the SPMS LMSC Aquatics Program Developer.
